Note: Where lion is incorporated on badge of rank, lion is always worn in a forward facing position. Badges of rank as shown are for left sleeve.

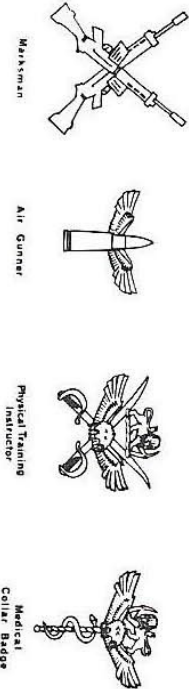
